Proof of Concept Launch - 1st Open POC Call - to £100K.

Call Opens: 2 March 2020 Deadline: 24 April 2020

EBNet POCs are a BBSRC/EPSRC-funded initiative aimed at supporting innovation and research.

Awards can range from up to £50K for single discipline, to £100K for cross discipline (multiinstitution) and £25K for desk-based studies. These are intended to enable accelerated innovation and progression through the Technology Readiness Levels (range 1-4). Awards are paid at 80% FEC and the applicant must be BBSRC eligible. Deadline: 18 May 2020 Awards have a value of up to £1,500 for UK-based placements and £3,000 for overseas placements. More <u>here</u>.
