New Year, New You? There are all sorts of tests available that promise to provide insight into your true self – some free, some expensive – which are not hard to find. (Note - we do not recommend *any*). Commercial DNA tests abound which offer information on ancestry, health or other traits. Personality tests online range from the horoscope level to "self-authoring", "critical thinking", "international citizenship" or psychometric. Some may be based at a University near you. If you cannot resist, free ones can be found at the University of Cambridge <u>Psychometrics Centre</u>.

Or look outwards to <u>UKRI GtR</u> to scope out projects that have recent funding. Pop in a quick keywork search in your topic for a horizon-scan to anticipate future findings.
