It is with immense sadness that the EB Network has learned of the death of <u>Professor</u> <u>Simon McQueen-Mason</u>.

Based at the Department of Biology, University of York, he directed two large EU consortia, was the director of two BBSRC Networks in Industrial Biology LBNet and BBNet, and he was Director of CNAP from 2014 to 2020. He had many international collaborators and his relaxed laid-back manner put everyone at ease in his company. He will be sorely missed by his friends and colleagues across the world.
