NOW OPEN

Open Proof of Concept Call – up to £100K Deadline: 24 April 2020

EBNet POCs are a BBSRC/EPSRC-funded initiative aimed at supporting innovation and research. Awards can range from up to £50K for single discipline, to £100K for cross discipline (multi-institution) and £25K for desk-based studies. These are intended to enable accelerated innovation and progression through the Technology Readiness Levels (range 1-4). Awards are paid at 80% FEC and the applicant must be BBSRC eligible. Spotlight On...

Innovation and TRL levels

There are now more avenues than ever to promote lasting impact from your research.

Progression through the "Technology Readiness Levels" is one of the key parameters for our current POC Call.

An academic working with Industry in a consortium or partnership will already have a sound grasp of basic IP issues (a.k.a. post-grads & proprietary tech in the age of Instagram - anecdotes anyone?) - or dealing with contractual IP agreements before a project can even start. Universities generally have internal sources of help.

But what if you think your research has genuine commercial potential? Budding entrepreneurs should check out <u>ICURe</u> for extensive personal support developing a business from your early research. UKRI has pipelines in place at all levels to support innovation like the <u>Enterprise Fellowship</u> or <u>Follow-on Funding</u>.

Want to see what challenges Industry deem important? Take a look at the <u>KTN-innovation eXchange</u> - a cross sector program supporting innovation transfer by matching industry challenges to innovative solutions from other sectors for faster development. Current challenges include finding alternative routes for producing "difficult" chemicals.

There are also <u>Connecting Capability</u> Centres cover much of the UK including <u>Thyme</u>, <u>Clean Growth UK</u> and <u>SETsquared</u> amongst others.
