### News

The first specialist webinar in our planned series to replace the Research Colloquium attracted a high degree of interest - including many old and new industry members - which is most welcome! Together, Dr Drew Wang, Virginia Tech, USA and Prof. Jeremy Webb, National Biofilms Innovation Centre (NBIC) explored the biology and engineering of Aerobic Granules guided by our able Chair, Dr Yongqiang Liu, University of Southampton. On the side of "nature" - insights included the growing role of RAMAN spectroscopy for real time monitoring, the role of Nitric Oxide, Quorum Sensing Inhibitors and Bacteriophages in biofilms and granule biogeography. And from "nurture" the interplay of Feast/Famine regimes and Settling Velocity selection pressures (amongst other operational parameters) to granule formation in real waste water case studies. Personally, I hadn't considered the role of evolution at the community scale in that way before. What was your takeaway? Do let us know your thoughts at the post-event survey <u>here</u>.
