Innovate UK have created a Sustainable Carbon Ambition for the UK Chemicals Industry called *Ambition 2050*. The main aim is for the UK chemicals industry to double economic output and source 80% of its carbon requirements from non-virgin fossil, sustainable carbon sources. Read more here.

Global Centres Congratulations!

Funding awards have been announced in the multimillion pound Global Centres in Clean Energy and Climate Change competition. These awards focus on advancing bioeconomy research to solve global challenges, whether by increasing crop resilience, converting plant matter or other biomass into fuel, or paving the way for biofoundries to scale up applications of biotechnology for societal benefit. The UK leads of the six centres are the University of Surrey, Imperial College London, University of Oxford, The University of Manchester, Scottish Association for Marine Science, and Earlham Institute. Professor Jhuma Sadhukhan (Col of EBNet), University of Surrey and Angela Bywater (EBNet Co-Manager) are participating in the Global Centre for Sustainable Bioproducts spearheading the world's first 3D-printed biopolymers.
